SNAP exam is scheduled on three different dates in December 2024. SNAP test duration is reduced to one hour. Due to these changes, SNAP Exam pattern is also changed like reduced number of questions, type of questions, scoring pattern, sectional composition among other key changes. So, before getting deep into the changed SNAP syllabus, we should know the key changes in SNAP exam pattern 2024 and its impact on MBA SNAP syllabus 2024:

Quantitative, Data Interpretation & Data Sufficiency Questions: 20	<p>This section syllabus comprises questions on Quantitative Aptitude, Data Interpretation & Data Sufficiency.
